This Fund offers financial assistance to Women from Presbyterian Parishes and Uniting Congregations.

Applicants are expected to be actively involved in the life of the Church where they regularly attend.

Courses of study will not need to be specifically theological, but grants will not be given for any study or training which is contrary to the beliefs and principles of the Presbyterian Church. APPLICATIONS FORMS are available from the National Secretary.

Please ensure that you ONLY use the current application form~ APPLICATIONS will be received at any time for study still to be undertaken, no retrospective applications will be considered.

TYPE OF ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE

- (a) Lay leadership training and ongoing education.
- (b) Assistance may be given for tertiary academic courses provided the application includes proof of satisfactory progress. This is not considered for the first year of study directly when the applicant is commencing straight from school.
- (c) Tertiary Education for children of Missionaries or Church Workers
