

Sample chart: VOLUNTARY HOURS worked in a Church in one month
(You could use this format to prepare your own chart for grant applications)

How many hours do your parishioners work for your church every month? See the example below: if you have a medium sized parish and your parishioners collectively work in your church for 130 hours per week, this is the equivalent of **3.4 full time equivalent voluntary workers** per 37.5 hour week.*

**Note, these figures do not include hours worked in the voluntary sector beyond the parish, such as volunteering at Citizens Advice etc.*
