

## **Volunteer Teaching Positions in Port Vila**

The Presbyterian Church of Vanuatu (PCV) is looking for two Christian people (if possible a husband and wife team) to introduce the new curriculum at the Korvan Community Health School in 2018 for a period of 2 years (24 months)



Korvan was originally developed to train students to work in First Aid Posts and Clinics throughout Vanuatu by the Korean Presbyterian Church and the Korean branch of the Presbyterian Church in Aotearoa New Zealand.

Korvan has since been handed over to the PCV at the PCV Assembly 2016.

A new curriculum has been developed and approved by the Vanuatu Ministry of Health and the VQA.

We now need to start planning the curriculum delivery.

We envision the course having a maximum of 50 students. The course is a Nurse Aid Training Course and is of one school year duration.

The goal is that students graduating from the course will

- continue with further study at the Nursing College of Education, or
- work as a nurse aid in a hospital, or
- work as a primary health care worker in an Aid Post or Clinic on one of the Vanuatu Islands.

As part of the course, students gain clinical experience on placement at a hospital or at an Aid Post or Clinic. During this time the teacher will not have any student contact hours.

Korvan is seeking two lecturing/teaching roles;

1. Nurse Lecturer
2. Language and Literacy Teacher

Korvan is committed to the provision of quality teaching and learning opportunities that will enable students to either enter into further study for a Diploma or Degree, or to enter the workforce.

### **Nurse Lecturer-Educator**

Korvan is seeking a person with experience in lecturing Nursing, who also has knowledge of unit standards and assessment processes, including moderation.

Either a Bachelor or Masters in Nursing is required.

They need the curriculum to be developed into teaching/learning units, so that as they move forward they can explore appointing a Ni Van into the role. That person will be able to utilise the teaching/learning units that have been developed.

### **Language and Literacy Teacher**

Korvan requires an English language teacher for people learning English for Specific Purposes (ESP).

You will need to have at least a Bachelor's qualification and a Teaching qualification.

The role will include

- diagnostic assessment of level of English
- development of a course of study to reflect the academic language learning needs of students in relation to the course content
- a focus on developing literacy skills in relation to course content

### **Further Information**

The role comes with accommodation supplied in Port Vila. You will be responsible for electricity, gas and water expenses.

This is an interesting new position which will help to upskill young people and improve the standard of healthcare in Vanuatu. Global Mission may be able to offer some living expenses for the role but it is largely a voluntary position.
