About the organisation and the project:

Gulf Christian Services is an Independent, interdenominational faith-based organisation operating in the very remote Gulf Province on the southern coast of Papua New Guinea. It administers two hospitals in the area, Kikori and Kapuna. Kapuna Hospital has been the only health service accessibly by approximately 35 000 people in the Gulf since 1949 when it was founded by the London Missionary Society. In 2018 we received a large Australian funded grant, through the PNG Incentive Fund, to rebuild the hospital buildings. This includes the hospital building themselves, ancillary buildings, a new floating wharf, water supply and solar electricity. Building on site began in January 2019.

Responsibilities:

- Lead a team of local building trainees and junior contractors in construction work
- Maintain health and safety amongst your team
- Liaise with the Site Manager regarding the building project
- Provide practical training in building techniques and best practice to local trainees
- Monitor and evaluate the competence of the trainees in your team and liaise with the Site Manager regarding human resource considerations
- Manage the tools required by your team and liaise with the Storeman regarding building materials for your work
