




I Love Taiwan Mission 2016

Aim

Training in Mission: For young people to experience God's grace and love, to learn and live out their faith, and to challenge them to devote themselves to God through the participation in mission; and further, be willing to be involved in ecumenical movement and construct a life of identification, devotion and growth.

Objectives

- To widen overseas youth's knowledge and understanding about people and the church in Taiwan through mission involvement (e.g. teaching English in summer camp) in a cross cultural and multi-religious context alongside Taiwan's young people.
- 2. Develop a network among overseas youth, Taiwanese youth and churches.
- 3. Leadership training and nurturing through participation in community mission and evangelism.
- 4. Motivate ecumenical involvement in local churches.

Dear Ecumenical Brothers and Sisters in Christ

Shalom, warm greeting from the Youth Ministry Committee of the Presbyterian Church in Taiwan, May the love and grace of God in Trinity always be with you.

Do you remember the moment when you met God in the first time? People react differently when they meet God. Some might feel nervous just like Moses on his journey to the sacred temple, some might feel protected just like Elijah who is saved from the burning fire, and some might feel loved like Shulamite and her beloved.

When the life of Job was down in the dump, the Lord revealed to him and Job confessed: \(^{\text{I}}\) I have heard of thee by the hearing of the ear: but now mine eye see thee. \(^{\text{J}}\) We can only surpass the limitation of people's mind by encountering with the lord, which is the most precious present from God. The Lord is the final answer, and the belief is born from here.

After encountering with the Lord, the youth Jeremiah received the calling bravely, and became the prophet in his time. Zacchaeus' life repented because of the acceptance from Jesus. The example matches with what the theologist Søren Aabye Kierkegaard said "the Leap of Faith", and this idea has become a key of being a Christian.

This year "2016 I love Taiwan Mission Camp- the present from God" is going to begin! This summer, let us share and review the touching moment when we first encounter the Lord. We believe we can meet the Lord again while exploring every spot of Taiwan and serving local churches with ecumenical youths. We can receive the one of a kind present from the Lord, from Taiwan and from ILT. And the present is unique for every one of us.


