ATESEA Accreditation Team Visit

TTC is an accredited member of the Association for Theological Education in South East Asia (ATESEA) and, as such, undergoes an accreditation review every five years. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the country's political situation, the reviewers were unable to visit in 2020. This year, a team of four reviewers visited the college: Rev. Dr. Nang Sawm Piang (President, Association of Theological Education in Myanmar



(ATEM) & Tedim Christian College, Yangon), Rev. Dr. Zaw Latt Aung (Executive Secretary, ATEM, Yangon), Rev. Dr. Joel Za Hlei Kap (Principal, Chin Christian Institute of Theology, Falam), Thramu Mi Mi Htoo (Librarian, Kothabyu Theological Seminary,



Patheingyi). The team conducted a two-day review of TTC on November 24-25, 2025. The college prepared extensively for the visit and hosted the team. The reviewers



meticulously assessed the various educational programs through individual and group interviews. A favorable result is

expected shortly, which will allow ATESEA to continue recognizing and accrediting TTC's degree programs.
