Vanuatu Travel Subsidy

The PCANZ has received a generous donation which will allow us to offer travel subsidies for volunteers who want to offer their services in Vanuatu this year, supporting our Pacific Vision Vanuatu partnership with the Presbyterian Church of Vanuatu (PCV). The main focus for this will be cyclone recovery. Because the impact of the cyclone was so extensive, this covers almost every aspect of life in the country. So enquiries are invited from members of PCANZ and Uniting Congregations who would like to serve in a short-term capacity in Vanuatu.



Opportunities are available to assist in a wide range of ways – building projects, education, reading support, health, social services, pastoral ministry, and tutoring in crafts and vocational skills.

This offer applies to individuals and to teams, and is capped at \$500 per person.

In most cases the Global Mission Coordinator will liaise with the applicant and the PCV to find the most appropriate placement. Once an applicant has been accepted, the funds will be transferred to assist with travel costs. Accommodation will usually be the volunteers' own arrangements. In some circumstances this may sometimes be coordinated with local hosts but should be factored into the overall costs of the short-term service.
