NURSE AIDE TRAINER

Brief Information

The Presbyterian Church of Vanuatu (PCV) is looking for an interested volunteer to assist with training at the Korvan Community Health School to deliver the Nurse Aide Certificate 3 level course. Korvan Community Health School is a Church run Institution.

A Nurse Aide curriculum has been developed and now awaiting accreditation by the Validation Committee of the Vanuatu Qualification Authority.

The Korvan Council needs to start planning for the curriculum delivery.

We envision the course having a maximum of 25 students. The duration of the Course is 9 Months.

The goal is that students graduating from the course will

- continue with further study at the Nursing College of Education, or
- work as a nurse aid in a hospitals and Health Centres, or
- work as a primary health care worker in an Aid Post or Clinic on one of the Vanuatu Islands.

Requirements

To become a nurse aid trainer in Vanuatu, you need to meet the requirements outlined by the [Vanuatu Qualifications Authority \(VQA\)](#) within the Vanuatu Qualifications Framework (VQF). This typically involves holding a relevant nursing or healthcare qualification, demonstrated teaching experience, and meeting specific VQA standards for training providers.

Specific requirements for nurse aid trainers within the VQF include:

- **Minimum Qualifications:**

A nursing or healthcare qualification relevant to nurse aid training, likely at a Certificate IV or higher level within the VQF.

- **Teaching Experience:**

Proven experience in training or educating others in healthcare settings, including demonstrating an ability to deliver effective instruction and assessment.

- **VQA Standards:**

Nurse aid trainers must align with the VQA's requirements for training providers, including demonstrating the necessary resources, processes, and qualified staff for delivering accredited courses.

- **Curriculum Compliance:**

Ensuring that training programs align with VQA-endorsed training packages, which include Units of Competency, Assessment Guidelines, and the VQF itself.

- **Professional Development:**

Staying current with industry best practices and ongoing professional development to maintain expertise in nurse aid training.

Accommodation and Living Expenses

The role comes with accommodation supplied in Port Vila. You will be responsible for electricity, gas and water expenses.

We are hoping that the Partner Churches may be able to fund living expenses for the role
