
FREE RESOURCES FOR FAITH LEADERS AFTER A DEATH BY SUICIDE


If you are leading a funeral/farewell or supporting a bereaved whānau or family after a suicide loss, these recent resources from the Mental Health Foundation offers practical advice and very helpful information. The Mental Health Foundation, a respected charity championing mental health, consulted with experienced ministry leaders from a range of Christian churches nationally, as well as celebrants and others, to develop these two resources.

Putting together a farewell ceremony after a suicide death can be especially challenging. These guidelines can give you confidence about the key things to keep in mind, as you both lead funeral/farewell planning and support those bereaved.



Funerals in Aotearoa after a death by suicide (1) Guidance for faith leaders, celebrants, funeral directors, whānau leaders, kaumātua, or anyone leading a funeral or hui mate for a person who died by suicide or suspected suicide. It will accompany you as you walk alongside the bereaved whānau through the farewell process, kōrero/talk safely about suicide, and take care of yourself throughout this time.

Funerals in Aotearoa after a death by suicide (2) Guidance for bereaved whānau and families planning a loved one's farewell after a death by suicide or suspected suicide - and for those supporting them. This resource can support bereaved whānau and families as they plan a loved one's funeral or hui mate in a way that honours their life, addresses suicide safely, and helps them cope with their grief. You will also find this practical information helpful if you're supporting someone bereaved by suicide.
